The Indiana State Department of Health has recently updated their guidance for COVID-19 protocols in schools throughout our state. To ensure the safety of our staff, students and visitors, we will be following the updated guidelines while continuing to adhere to local health department requirements.

Beginning Friday, March 4, 2022:

- All Excel Center locations will be mask optional and all contact tracing will cease.
- Quarantines will only be required for students and staff who test positive; an individual who tests positive will need to quarantine for five (5) days.
- KN95 masks will be made available to any staff or student who wants them, through the end of the school year.
